## Nursery Rhymes

Focus on settling the children into school for the first few weeks by building up their confidence to share songs, stories, rhymes that they already know. Getting to know you: opportunities for the children to share personal stories about their family, friends, likes and dislikes, assessing the children's baseline levels by providing opportunities for the children to explore and experience all

curriculum areas.



## **Favourite Stories**

We will be reading lots of familiar stories to encourage the children to share their favourite stories and to develop their listening and attention skills. We will be playing lots of games with these stories and challenging the children to order the story pictures. We will be using our listening ears lots this half term and going for a sound walk to see what we can hear. We will be playing lots of listening games and turn taking games in readiness for learning our first phonemes.
