		Maths	30-50m <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Shows an interest in representing quantities</li> <li>Realises not only objects, but anything can be counted, including steps, claps and jumps.</li> <li>Beginning to use mathematical language to describe 2D and 3D shapes.</li> </ul>	40-60m <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Counts objects to 10, and beginning to count beyond 10</li> <li>In practical activities and discussion, beginning to use the vocabulary involved in adding and subtracting.</li> <li>Orders two or three items by length or height.</li> <li>Says the number that is one less than a given number.</li> </ul>
