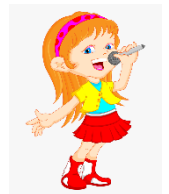

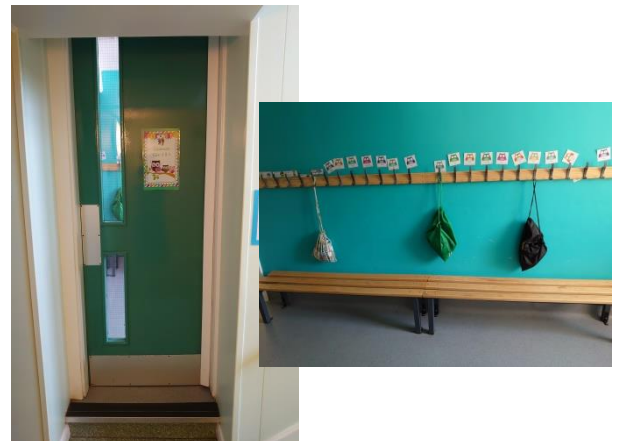


You will come to school through the hall door, walk through the hall and up the stairs. We share our cloakroom and toilets with Class 3.

Class 4's Door

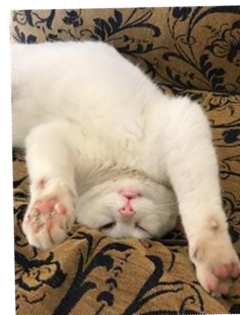
Home time door
