Confirmation of school place during lockdown - Information for Key Worker / Vulnerable Children

5 January 2021

Dear Parents and Carers,

I can now confirm that in accordance with government guidance regarding the current national lockdown your child has been allocated a place in school to start from tomorrow, Wednesday 6th January 2021.

For learning continuity, your child will be expected to attend school every day Monday to Friday, i.e. no part-time places are available during this period. If you do NOT wish to take up the school place please contact us to let us know as soon as possible.

Children will be taught in their year group 'bubbles' with designated staff and will remain socially distanced from other bubbles and staff during the day.

Children must be dropped off and collected by an adult. Parents must wait with their child, socially distanced from others, until the children go inside to their teacher. **To minimise risk, only one parent or carer should enter the school site with their child.** For the safety of everyone, your child **MUST** stand with you and **NOT** mix with other children.

Please continue to use the one-way system in place on the school site and wear a mask when you are on the school site.


Your send your child in full uniform every day with a warm coat, hat and gloves, their water bottle and book bag.

Please be aware that if we have a positive Covid-19 case in school we may need to close your child's bubble at short notice in line with Public Health guidance.

We will be reviewing procedures on a daily basis, as we may need to make adjustments. We thank you, in advance, for your continued patience, understanding and co-operation.
