Free School Meals

Schools have now been advised that the free school meal voucher scheme is to relaunch from next week. The scheme offers supermarket vouchers worth £15 a week for each child eligible for benefit-based free school meals.

When the scheme launched during the first lockdown schools experienced delays accessing the system. Therefore, until we know the system is working correctly, we will provide eligible families with a food parcel again next week. Providing there are no problems we will order the vouchers for distribution to parents from week commencing Monday 25 January.

We will contact parent/carers by text when the parcels are ready for collection. Please let school know if you are unable to collect your parcel. Please note we ask that parent/carers collect their parcels as soon as possible as we do not have the facilities to refrigerate the large amount of fresh produce.
