- 04. Relive them by remembering them in detail.




Magical Maths

This week, we are focusing on 3D shapes. The picture below will help the children to remember shape names, what they look like and the properties of the shapes. As mentioned when we looked at 2D shapes, when looking at the properties of the shapes, we are keen for the children to use the mathematical term of 'vertices' rather than corner when describing the shapes.



The children can go on a shape hunt, comparing the size of the 3D shapes and ordering them. They could then go around the house, garden or local area and spot different shapes. They could create a tally chart to mark down what they see on their shape adventure.

Using marshmallows, playdough or modelling clay and matchsticks, cocktail sticks or straws they could make 3D models. Models could also be made out of Lego or building blocks. Why don't you email photos of your models to school to show your class teacher?




