School Hours

School starts at 9:00am (the doors open at 8:50am for your child to come into class or the hall). Our caretaker closes the gates at 9:00am. If you arrive after this time, please enter via the main office door. Registration closes at 9:05am after which time your child will receive a late mark on the register. Our school office opens at 8:15am and closes at 4:00pm. The office will be closed from 8:25am -8:45am on a Tuesday. You can always send us a text or leave a voicemail out

of office hours.

General Uniform and Equipment Information

We ask that you please ensure <u>all</u> your child's uniform, coats and shoes are clearly named; if a child misplaces part of their uniform, it is much easier to return it to them when it is named. If it is not, we cannot guarantee it will get back to them. Please send your child with a named waterproof coat every day. We also ask that your child brings in a clear water bottle (for sale on the School Money app) and that it only contains water. Please do not put water bottles in bookbags as these can damage reading books.





We Keep Children Safe By...

...asking that you use the designated paths in and around school and **do not** walk through our school car park. Our car park is very busy during the day, especially at drop off and pick up due to staff members/school visitors arriving and leaving the school grounds. In order to minimise any risk, please walk with your children along the pavement on Lightcliffe Road and up the walkways either side of school.

Other safety reminders:

- Please do not park on any yellow lines around the school building, these allow for families to enter and exit the school grounds safely.
- Please respect our neighbours and do not block their drives when dropping off/collecting children.
- Please do not park in the staff car park unless you have permission from the school.
