Just a quick introduction to Family Hubs

Do you know what the Family Hubs are?

Family Hubs are an evolution from Children's Centre's.

What do they do?

All families need support from time to time to help babies and children thrive, whether that's from friends, family, volunteers, or practitioners. Family Hubs are here to help every family receive the support they need, when they need it.

Where are they?

There are five Family Hub areas in the borough which join up locally in the planning and delivery of family services from conception to young people up to 19 years or up to 25 years for those with Specialist Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND). The range of activities, groups, advice and support are tailored based on the needs of the local community.

Where can you attend?

Did you know you no longer have to attend just your local hub? You can access all the hubs in the borough.

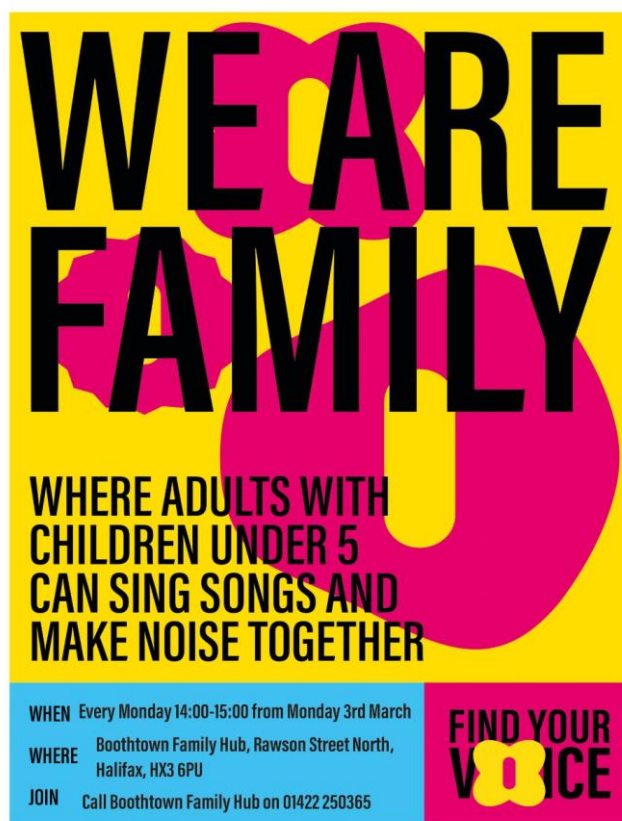
