Our focus this half term will be:-

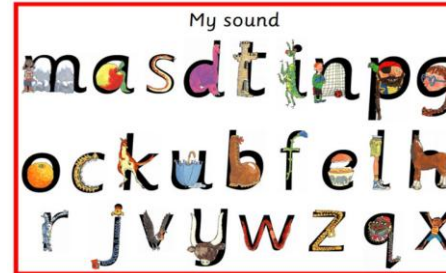
